

How to prepare for K?


The A to I of Kindergarten Readiness

		Alphabet: can recognize uppercase & lowercase letters	Bathroom: can use the bathroom independently	Concepts of print: knows how to hold a book and track words	<u>Directions:</u> can follow oral directions given to the class	Eat independently: can open and close snack & lunch	Finger grip: Can hold a pencil with thumb and fingers
	Get dressed: can independently put on and take off their coat	Handwriting: can print their name	Independence: can problem solve small issues	Just right noise level: can control their voice in different settings	Kind: is kind to others and can share	Letter sounds: can produce lettersounds	Minutes: can focus on a specific task for 10-15 minutes

How else can I help my child get ready for K?

- ♦ Sleep and food critical to education
- Attention and focus
- Pencil grip
- Name recognition and writing
- Number recognition and counting
- Life skills tying shoes, zipping coat, opening containers

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WaKIDS

- All LWSD kindergarten students are offered free full-day kindergarten
- ♦ Family Connection Meetings are a key component of WaKIDS family meets with teacher
- ♦ Family Connection Meetings are September 5-7 you will sign up for a time via a Sign-Up Genius link sent out after Meet and Greet in August
- **♦ First Day of school for KINDERGARTEN is September 8th**

Homework

♦ At the kinder level, homework involves reading every night and math homework.

♦ Teachers will share ideas in e-newsletters for working with your student at home (e.g., identifying shapes).



Highly Capable (K-2 HC)

- Kindergarten testing for HC is by parent nomination
- Application period in October
- ♦ Watch LWSD website for information updates will be posted by the first day of school
- Students can qualify in ELA and/or Math
- Services provided at Mann on a pull-out basis

Lunches / Snacks

- Students carry their own lunch to the lunchroom
- ♦ 25 minutes to eat, then recess
- ♦ Instructional Assistants will be in the lunchroom to help students open juice boxes, etc.
- Students will sit by class and teachers will stay for the first few minutes to make sure students are settled in.
- Students are encouraged to bring lunch the first two weeks.

Playground

- Students currently have 3 recesses
 - Morning Recess and Afternoon Recess 15 minutes
 - ♦ Lunch Recess 30 minutes
- Instructional Assistants supporting students outside during recess
- Indoor recess when the weather is too stormy to be outside
- Soccer Field is not open for Kindergarten students

Morning Lineup

- ♦ Students will line up outside their teacher's classroom doors
- ♦ Instructional Assistants/Patrol members will watch the classes during this time



- Classroom volunteers


